## **Get in the Act! Student Behavior Contract**

Get in the Act Student Behavior Contract is designed to protect student rights and to inform students and parents of acceptable classroom behavior and the consequences of misconduct. All students enrolled in Get in the Act programs will be held responsible for the content and intent of this document. Non receipt of the contract does not nullify the agreement's intent. All Rules will be upheld whether or not the agreement is signed.

**Get in the Act staff will protect each individual student's right to:**

- ***Learn in an environment free of violence.***
- ***Learn in a classroom free of constant disruption.***
- ***Learn in a non-threatening, safe, and caring environment.***
- ***Participate in classes without prejudice or harassment of any kind.***

1. Students will arrive at class on time, prepared and ready to learn each day. Students will be polite and respectful to teachers and staff. Students will cooperate and follow instructions. Students will conduct themselves with good manners, kindness towards others, and respect for all. Students have a responsibility to come prepared to class by working at home to have memorized lines, reviewed staging, songs and movement. During class time each student is responsible for assisting in set-up and strike. After a performance students are responsible for neatly placing costume and props in appropriate places.

2. Students will raise their hand to be recognized and may not inflict disruptive behavior on his or her classmates. Disruptive behavior prevents the teacher from teaching and other students from learning. Disruptive behavior will result in a student's dismissal from the program.

3. Students will work and learn cooperatively together and not hurt others. Hurting others physically is contrary to our Student Rights policy regarding a violence free environment. Students who hit others will be immediately dismissed from the program.

4. Students must use acceptable language and must not spit. Inappropriate language is not allowed at school. Students who are spitting or using foul language will be dismissed from the program.

5. Students will care appropriately for all costumes, props and set pieces. A rule in theater is, if your character does not use a particular prop in a performance 'do not touch it.' Destruction of property, including the facility, is forbidden. Parents will be held financially responsible for loss of material. If a student cannot conduct themselves with self-control and in a respectful behavior towards the facility, i.e. classroom and performance spaces they will be dismissed from the program.

6. Students must remain with a teacher or counselor at all times. It is forbidden for any student to leave the facility at any time without a parent or parent-designated adult. Students may not run away or hide. This behavior is a very serious concern due to the threat to child safety and will result in dismissal from the program.

7. Students will be honest and truthful in the classroom. Stealing is not permitted and will result in dismissal from the program.

8. Students will be treated fairly, without prejudice, and with courtesy. No child will receive unfair or prejudicial treatment from the faculty. All students should demonstrate common courtesy toward each other. Harassment or teasing between students will result in dismissal from the program.

9. Solving Problems – All students must learn to solve problems through appropriate means. In response to a threat, teasing, or injury, students should TALK—USE YOUR WORDS, GET HELP FROM TEACHERS.
